

Turner Feature Animation Hollywood, California



The project consists of a digital animation studio and production offices for the West Coast headquarters of this media company and was specifically designed for the production of their Art Deco-era animated feature film "Cats Don't Dance".

Designed to reflect the Art-Deco sensibility of the film, the lobby includes the extensive use of rich woods and iconic lighting. The animation studio is laid out in a series of clustered workstations served by a central computer room. Special indirect light fixtures were specified to avoid glare on computer terminals and electronic dimming ballasts were utilized to reduce interference with computer systems. The studio walls, floor, ceiling and workstation surfaces are finished in neutral grays that allow for accurate color rendering on the computer screens.
